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WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW BEFORE PAINTING

1- Where can be used
For indoor decorating and adding privacy at home and office, including glass surface in bathroom, kitchen, bedroom, sliding door, window, etc.

2- Where can't be used
For food safety, this product is not applicable to any food storage cups, plates, etc.

3- Surface preparation
Before using frosted glass paint on any surface, it is important to thoroughly clean and prepare the surface to ensure proper adhesion and a smooth finish. The surface to be painted must be clean, dry, and free of dust, dirt, oil, and other contaminants. Any imperfections or rough spots should be sanded down and smoothed out.

4- Mixing the paint
It is important to mix the paint thoroughly before use. If it has been sitting for a while, there may be separation, so be sure to stir it well until it is smooth and consistent.

5- Technique
When painting with glass paint, it is important to use long, smooth strokes to ensure even coverage. Avoid over-brushing or going back over areas that have already been painted, as this can cause streaking or unevenness.

6- Drying time

PREP WORK

1- Clean the surface
Before applying the paint, it's important to thoroughly clean the surface to remove any dirt, grease, or other contaminants. Use a degreaser or a mixture of water and dish soap to clean the surface, and rinse it thoroughly with clean water. Dry the surface with a clean cloth.

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2- Masking

APPLICATION

Once the first coat is dry, apply a second coat of paint. Again, start at the top and work your way down, using long, even strokes. Make sure to cover the entire surface evenly. Let the second coat dry (recommended drying time is 1.5-2 h).

5- Let the final coat dry
Once you've applied all necessary coats of paint, let the final coat dry completely according to the recommended drying time (1.5-2 h).

6- Use
The paint may be slightly used after 24 hours of drying, and it will be completely dried and ready for normal use after 7 days.

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7- Clean-up
This paint can be dissolved in water, so it can be easily cleaned using water. Clean your brushes, rollers, or spray gun thoroughly with water. Dispose of any unused paint according to local regulations.

By following these application steps, you'll ensure that the paint is applied evenly and correctly, which will result in a beautiful and long-lasting finish.

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MAINTENANCE

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TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem: Paint is not adhering properly to the surface.
Solution: Make sure the surface is clean and free of grease, rust, and other contaminants. If necessary, use a degreaser or sandpaper to prepare the surface before painting. Follow the preparation steps outlined in the Preparation section of this manual.

Problem: Paint is peeling or cracking.
Solution: This may be due to a surface that was not properly prepared, or due to moisture or humidity. Make sure the surface is dry before painting, and avoid painting in high humidity conditions. Sand down any areas of peeling or cracking and reapply the paint.

Problem: Paint is bubbling.
Solution: This may be due to moisture or contamination on the surface. Sand down any areas of bubbling and reapply the paint. Make sure the surface is completely dry before painting.

Problem: Paint is too thin or too thick.
Solution: If the paint is too thin, it may be due to over-thinning with solvents. If it's too thick, it may be due to improper mixing or application. If you find that the paint is too thick or if you need to use a spray gun, the recommended dilution ratio is less than 5%.

If you experience any other issues with the paint, consult the label or contact the manufacturer for further assistance.

FAQ

Q Is it permanent? Or can it be removed?
The paint can be removed, and there are various methods to do so. We recommend using a paint stripper to remove the paint effectively.

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Q For residential jobs, should you paint the exterior of the window or the interior?
Paint it inside the window.

Q Does it block sunlight?
The more you paint on the thicker it is. It will block direct sunlight. But it still lets light shine through. You can see light and shadows through it but not actual objects/people.

Q Can this product be used on a glass shower door?
Yes! Use it on the side of the glass that is not exposed to the water as much, this way it will stay longer.

Q Can this paint be used outdoors? What the coverage of a kit of this ?
No, it can't be used outdoors. Our standard is to apply two coats, which can cover about 25sq.ft.
